



The first ProSPER.Net Leadership Programme was hosted by the East West Center in Honolulu, Hawaii, from 16 to 24 November. Participants from 10 countries went through a unique experience that will assist them in leading efforts towards developing work with a clearer vision and understanding regarding diverse perspectives, focusing on collaborative efforts, leveraging networks and involving multiple stakeholders.
