Researchers' School was hosted by Chulalongkorn University, Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) and Prince of Songkla University (PSU) in Thailand from 9-20 September 2013. The theme of this year's school was 'Partnerships in Water and Biodiversity for Sustainable Development'.

The main goal of the YRS is to provide graduate students and young post-doctoral researchers with an opportunity to better understand the spectrum of challenges that underpin sustainable development. By assembling these young researchers together for an intensive 2-week workshop, the school also fosters the growth of a network of sustainability scholars and professionals in the Asia-Pacific region.
