Terms & Conditions of UNU-IAS's Financial Support

1. A UNU-IAS funded participant is required to take an active role during the programme as well as in the preparatory and follow-up activities.
2. Daily Substance Allowance (DSA) per UNU regulations of USD 1,056 for the duration of your participation in the YRS programme (15–22 December 2024) will be provided after the completion of the programme. Please note that the DSA amount may be subject to change based on the monthly rate set by UN regulations.
3. The DSA is intended to partially cover necessary costs for participating in the programme, including accommodation and meals. Any expenses exceeding this amount must be covered by the participants themselves.
4. Participants are required to purchase a round-trip flight ticket, obtain a visa (if necessary), and secure travel insurance at their own expense. Overseas travel insurance must be arranged and covered by the participants. UNU-IAS will not be responsible for any accidents or emergencies that may occur during the programme
5. It is the participant's responsibility to obtain an appropriate visa to the Sri Lanka if applicable. Please note that UNU-IAS is authorized to cancel your participation if your visa is not issued one week before your departure date. Please inform us of your visa status as soon as your visa is secured.
6. A UNU-IAS funded participant must participate in the entire programme and sign the attendance sheet each day for the full duration of the event.
7. A UNU-IAS funded participant must submit a digital copy of their boarding pass within two weeks of returning home. Failure to submit the boarding pass will prevent UNU-IAS from completing the payment process for the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA).
8. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions may result in the cancellation of fund support and programme participation, with any associated costs charged to the participant. UNU-IAS will not be responsible for personal expenses or charges incurred due to cancellation, which must be covered by the participant.
